### SCHOOL DISTRICT QUESTION 1 APPROVAL OF SCHOOL DISTRICT REFERENDUM REVENUE AUTHORIZATION

The board of Independent School District No. 281 (Robbinsdale) has proposed to increase its general education revenue by \$515 per pupil. The school district's actual referendum revenue authorization for any year shall not exceed the statutory maximum for that year. The proposed referendum revenue authorization would increase each year by the rate of inflation and be applicable for ten years, beginning with taxes payable in 2019, unless otherwise revoked or reduced as provided by law.

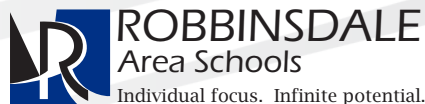
BY VOTING "YES" ON THIS BALLOT QUESTION, YOU ARE VOTING FOR A PROPERTY TAX INCREASE.

The majority of Minnesota school districts rely on operating levies to help fund school staff and operating costs.

Robbinsdale Area Schools' current operating levy is lower than most of its neighboring and comparable school districts.

The funds would support district efforts to maintain Robbinsdale Area Schools' academic and co-curricular programming for students.

If approved by voters, the estimated tax impact on the average homeowner would be less than \$12.50 per month.
