Did you know?

- Menus are available on the district web site rdale.org or at rdale.nutrislice.com. Download Nutrislice on your smartphone. Search for “School Lunch by Nutrislice” on GooglePlay or the App Store. Using our interactive website, you can see a description and nutrition facts for each item. Allergen and images for each item will be coming this year.
- Farm to School connects schools with fresh, local food grown or raised by family farmers. Robbinsdale Child Nutrition purchases locally grown foods, such as sweet corn, carrots, cucumbers, tomatoes and apples. For the last few years, Farmer Ed Rabideaux from Bayfield Fruit Company in Anoka, MN has provided our schools with delicious apples.
- Meal account balances and purchases can be viewed by registering with PayPams. Balances are also available on Parent Portal.
- Any balance in your student’s account whether negative or positive will transfer to the new school year. Parents are responsible for paying any unpaid lunch balances.

Payments can be made by sending a check or cash in an envelope with students name and grade. Payments may also be made on Paypams via credit card or direct from bank. Paypams charges a 4.6% transaction fee for deposits.

If you use Bill Pay through your banking facility, this is a good option for making payments as well.

- **An application for meal benefits is required each year.** Applications can be completed online at rdale.org. The link to apply can be found under the “Quick Links” section on the district webpage or your school’s home page. Paper applications are available in the school office. Parents may also go to rocketscan.rdale.org to apply online.

The district receives additional funding based on the number of students who qualify for meal benefits which goes directly to the classroom.
